The country has adopted a variety of scientific development MEP "Scientific basis of indicators of environmental conditions in the Republic of Kazakhstan"

"Research on the Environmental Assessment of Kazakhstan, the degree of utilization of natural resources, the impact of economic activity on the environment, and measures taken to reduce the negative impact on her and on the other", in addition to the basis of the state policy in the field of environmental protection were laid in ecological Security Concept approved by order of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan 30 April 1996, which considered the environmental priorities of the transitional period, in particular environmental problems of privatization, questions need to create a system of environmental legislation, state control and examination of economic mechanisms of environmental management, environmental monitoring.

The country also has a state environmental control and environmental monitoring.
