This enabled the institutions to participate fully in the site selection, preparation and celebration of the 2012 and 2013 World Desertification days. The celebrations were successfully held in the Mofale Hoek (2012) and Quthing (2013) districts. They are also participating in the Lesotho NAP alignment process. All these efforts were taken to promote participation by CSO's and STI's as well as increase awareness in all processes of the Convention.

IN order to overcome the challenges faced during the implementation of all Multi-lateral Environmental Agreements (MEA's) including three Rio Conventions ratified by Lesotho the National Coordination Strategy on Implementation of MEA's was developed. This led to the formation of the National Coordinating Committee for joint implementation and reporting of all Multi-lateral Environmental Agreements (MEA's) including three Rio Conventions. This committee is coordinated by the Ministry of Tourism, Environment and Culture. This Committee meets quarterly to report on the current projects and programs, planned activities, as well as progress on implementation of the MEA's and Rio Conventions. There is also a newly established National Climate Change Committee where other MEA's are members. The terms of references of the latter committee are yet to be finalised. The Lesotho Council of Non-Governmental Organisations (LCN) has a commission dedicated to Agriculture, Environment and Natural Resources, the Commissioner of which is a member of the previously mentioned committees. This gives a platform for all the CSO's that are members of the LCN to

During the NCSA process the Focal Point of the UNCCD was moved from being the National Environment Secretariat (NES) in the Ministry of Tourism, Environment and Culture to the Department of Soil and Water Conservation in the Ministry of Forestry and Land Reclamation in order to achieve a more focused approach to the implementation of the Convention.

The Country Strategic Investment Framework (CSIF) for SLM: Integrated Financing Strategy was formulated with the assistance of GM behalf of the TerrAfrica partnership under SLM project. This strategy was developed in 2013 with the purpose of scaling-up Sustainable Land and Water Management (SLWM) and reversing the adverse effects of DLDD. Successful implementation of SLWM lies in the ability of the country to mobilise the requisite resources namely human and financial. The logical framework for the resources mobilisation strategy for Lesotho is clearly outlined. the CSIF is yet to be implemented.

The Government of Lesotho has provided a 68% increase in funds for the implementation of the Integrated Watershed Management approach which is a best practice for SLM in Lesotho. This enabled the increase in the number of mini-catchments where the approach is being implemented from 160 to 240. These poverty alleviation projects in the mini-catchments cover the entire country and are meant to give people incentives while they rehabilitate their lands. It provides incentives to 96000 people each year
